Privacy Policy and Cookie Policy

This privacy statement provides you with details of how Culture and Climate Change will collect, store and use the personal data you supply to it.

Culture and Climate Change is committed to best practice in the handling of personal and sensitive data and careful compliance with requirements of GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations).

We take your privacy seriously and will only use your personal information to administer your transactions with us (online and offline) and to provide information about the events, resources and services you have requested. All data is collected and is currently processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act (1998) and GDPR (2018).

1. Collection of personal data

In using this website, you may provide certain personal data to Culture and Climate Change. By providing such information you consent to its use and storage in accordance with the provisions of this Privacy Policy. We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information.

2. Storage and correction of personal data

Culture and Climate Change will hold your information only for as long as necessary for each purpose we use it and to comply with our legal obligations. We are obliged to supply you, on request, with a copy of the personal data we hold about you in line with GDPR. We may charge an administration fee to respond to a subject access request. 3. Use of personal data

Culture and Climate Change may store personal data on applications to open schemes for awards and other opportunities for artists on our secure application portal. We will keep your information only for as long as is reasonably necessary in line with GDPR. We delete all unsuccessful applications for artists' grants and support, within 18 months after the application deadline and we delete unsolicited CVs sent to us by email.

Culture and Climate Change shall only use your personal information for the purposes for which it is provided or for purposes to which you have consented. In providing your name and email address, we will be able to contact you with information and news updates about Culture and Climate Change. We will ensure all communications you receive from us are relevant and of appropriate frequency. We collaborate with artists and organisations on a regular basis and we will only share your data when you have given consent or opted in. We do not allow third parties to use the data we collect.

4. Links to third party websites

Culture and Climate Change may provide links to third party websites and equally links to Culture and Climate Change may appear on third party websites. This privacy policy applies solely to the personal data collected by Culture and Climate Change and does not apply to third party websites and services that are not under our control.

Cookie Policy

We may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information which is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our website and to deliver a better and more personalised service. You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to our website.
